- i. Bowl Alberta reports that Wetaskiwin and Sylvan Lake have left the association.
- ii. YBC grads continue to get free Alberta 5 Pin memberships for the year after they graduate. Proprietors should mark their lists for the office with "graduated".
- iii. AlL insurance is no longer part of the five pin membership.
- iv. 18-21 year old bowlers are considered to be "Youth" for reporting to government and for proceeds from government run raffles, casinos, etc.

d. MASTER BOWLERS' ASSOCIATION OF ALBERTA REPORT - Pat

- Heritage Lanes will host a coaches clinic for first year coaches, called Community Sport Initiation (CSI). Spots are limited for the October 20th course. See the information at <u>www.centralalberta5pin.com</u>
- ii. Any coach who still has the old level 1 designation must take the Making Ethical Decisions module by December 31st, 2013 to keep their certification. Otherwise they will have to re-enter the coaching program by taking the CSI course. This course can be taken at a CSI course or online.
