#### 2015-2016 Budget at Board of Directors - September 27, 2015

I have put the budget together assuming we will have the same number of participants as last season.

Similarly, costs are based on previous seasons with allowance for the location of provincials and the number of days involved in attending those events.

I have increased entry fees by \$5 for the high low and Youth Challenge and \$10 to the Pins Over Average and Open events in an effort to try and slow the drawdown on funds until the next casino.

All other items are principally the same as last year.

Please note, I have a year over year spreadsheet that shows projected budgets over the next three seasons which shows that we may be in a precarious situation next year.

I will leave adoption of the budget until we have covered the tournaments, in the eventuality that any changes are required.
