# **President's Report to Director's Meeting**

In Donna's absence, I have a few comments.

I attended the AS AGM on Friday, the budget meeting on Saturday and the Masters Meeting on Sunday.

Additionally, I attended the C5 AGM meeting as an Alberta delegate in Ottawa in late August.

Most of these meetings would be described as routine with maintenance of the status quo being the theme.

Significantly the AS president, Annette Bruneau, won election as president of the Canadian S Pin Bowlers Association.

At the Canadian meeting it is now under discussion to reduce the number of bowlers in the Open having only four bowlers competing. Ladies and men's team would have one spare while the mixed would have one man and one lady on the bench. The mixed would have the opportunity of double pull.

The reason for this is that the event is continually running long each day, messing up banquets and other planned events. The reduction of two bowlers from each full contingent would result in a cost saving to the provinces as well as possibly reducing the number of days involved in the event.

The potential downside would be bowlers who are on the bubble to make the team may opt to not bowl in zones as they odds of making nationals would be reduced.

Bowlers will be polled to solicit their opinions.

At the Alberta level one change has been made to the Youth Challenge in that most teams don't have an opportunity to win the scratch tournament. What we will do is run a parallel event for all participants which will be pins over average. Awards will be made in the new event, meaning all zones have a reasonable opportunity to have some winners.

If there are any questions, I can attempt to answer them.

#### 2015-2016 Budget at Board of Directors - September 17, 2017

I have put the budget together assuming we will have the same number of participants as last season.

Similarly, costs are based on previous seasons with allowance for the location of provincials and the number of days involved in attending those events.

Thank you to the proprietors who have kept their lineage fee at \$5.50 per game for this season.

A couple of items I have changed.

- I have increased all entry fees by \$5.00 to try and slow the drawdown on funds until the next casino.
- I have included a cost of \$500 for the website, which is due next spring. The fee will give us two years of service.

All other items are principally the same as last year.

Please note, I have a year over year spreadsheet that shows projected budgets over the next few seasons which shows what we may expect in future season.

I will leave adoption of the budget until we have covered the tournaments, in the eventuality that any changes are required.
